Week of December 30

❑ **Military.** Pray for new believers in the military and for those who will put their faith in Christ this year. Pray for protection against the enemy of their souls. Pray for growth in their confidence in Christ and for victory over old habits and sin.

❑ **Cadence.** Pray for continued commitment in each of our staff to the centrality of the gospel and the finished work of Jesus. Pray for many opportunities to share this gospel and for the Spirit’s enabling and anointing as we share it.

❑ **Joining God.** This year may many military people find new life in Christ. “We are bringing you good news, telling you to turn from these worthless things to the living God, who made the heavens and the earth and the sea and everything in them.” Acts 14:15b

Week of January 6

❑ **Military.** Pray for the children of military personnel, that they would be drawn to Christ this year. Pray for special grace on each child who has to say goodbye to a parent for long periods of deployment.

❑ **Cadence.** Pray for all our youth and children’s workers, that God would give them strength and wisdom as they reach and disciple military dependents. Pray that God would raise up more youth and children’s workers.

❑ **Joining God.** May those who come to know Christ young walk with Him all their days. “Since my youth, God, you have taught me, and to this day I declare your marvelous deeds.” Psalm 71:17

Week of January 13

❑ **Military.** Pray for military believers who will be put in leadership positions this year or who are following new leaders. Pray for military people who are moving and will be starting fresh with jobs, friendships, and opportunities to minister.

❑ **Cadence.** Pray for our new Vice President of Operations, Travis Akins, as he finishes raising support and begins in this vital role at Cadence Headquarters.

❑ **Joining God.** May we follow in whatever ways God leads. “This is what the Lord says—your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: ‘I am the Lord your God, who teaches you what is best for you, who directs you in the way you should go.’” Isaiah 48:17

Week of January 20

❑ **Military.** Pray for a new hunger for God’s Word among military people. Pray for discernment to be able to sort through the myriads of voices one can hear every day. Pray that the Voice of God would be the clearest and that military people would be compelled to listen to and know Him through His Word.

❑ **Cadence.** Pray for our staff as they study and teach the Word of God each week. Pray that the Word would do its work in their hearts as well as in the hearts of those being taught.

❑ **Joining God.** May the alive and active Word of God be at home in our hearts. “Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.” Colossians 3:16-17

Week of January 27

❑ **Military.** Pray for revival among God’s people in the military. Pray for repentance from sin, renewal of minds through the transforming Word of God, and refreshment from the Holy Spirit. Pray that we would be able to look back on this year in the military and know that God did a mighty work which will bear fruit for His Kingdom for years to come.

❑ **Cadence.** Pray for God’s refreshment and revival over each of our Cadence staff. They are working hard and pouring out their lives. Pray that this year would be one of renewal and revitalizing in a way that we look back in Cadence and say that God did a mighty work which will bear fruit for His Kingdom for years to come.

❑ **Joining God.** May all that God does in us be part of what He uses to make His Name known among the nations. “Sing to the Lord a new song, for he has done marvelous things; his right hand and his holy arm have worked salvation for him. The Lord has made his salvation known and revealed his righteousness to the nations.” Psalm 98:1-2
